

Complete Student Loan Exit Counseling

Have you borrowed Federal Direct Loans (subsidized or unsubsidized)?

If you answered yes to this question, then you need to complete Exit Counseling for your loans as this is a requirement through Federal Student Aid. This is separate from any private loan(s) you may have had while attending Marietta College.

Why do I need to complete Exit Counseling?

Exit Counseling ensures you understand your student loan obligations and are prepared for repayment. You will learn about what payments look like after school. You will also receive a recommendation regarding repayment strategies that is best for you.

How long will this process take?

Exit Counseling takes about 30 minutes to complete. You must complete it in one session as your progress does not save. Sessions timeout after 15 minutes of inactivity.

What information do I need to complete Exit Counseling?

Have your FSA ID and password available so that you can log in along with any updated contact information. You can update your contact information in exit counseling by going to Communication Settings.
